Notice for Public Comment
File New PFC #7 Impose and Use Application

The Columbus Airport Commission ("the Commission") owner and operator of the Columbus Airport (CSG), is posting this public notice as part of the passenger facility charge (PFC) application process under 14 CFR §158.24 for the Columbus Airport. The Commission will be notifying the Federal Aviation Administration of its intent to submit a new \$4.50 impose and use PFC Application. As part of this process, the Commission is providing the Public following information regarding the referenced application.

The PFC charge level for all projects will be \$4.50. The estimated charge effective date will be October 1, 2019 and the estimated expiration date will be December 1, 2035 in order to collect \$3,086,312.

PROJECT DESCRIPTIONS

1. Obstruction Clearing Runway 6/24

Project Description: The aircraft approach to the east and west end of the main commercial service runway 06/24 contains a number of obstructions. This project will identify and implement the removal of these identified obstructions

Project Justification: This project will improve the safety of Airport operations by providing clear aircraft approaches

PFC Request Amount: \$94,195

PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50

2. Design Perimeter Road

Project Description: Large areas of the Airport lack a perimeter road system. Under this project a utility road parallel to the exterior perimeter fence of the Airport will be designed. This road will be used by: 1) security patrols, 2) ARFF vehicles, and 3) Airport maintenance units.

Project Justification: This project will improve the safety of Airport operations by allowing Airport safety, security, operations and maintenance vehicles access remote areas of the airfield and the perimeter of airport property.

PFC Request Amount: \$17,489

PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50

3. Construct Perimeter Road

Project Description: Large areas of the Airport lack a perimeter road system. Under this project a utility road parallel to the exterior perimeter fence of the Airport will be designed. This road will be used by: 1) security patrols, 2) ARFF vehicles, and 3) Airport maintenance units.

Project Justification: This project will improve the safety of Airport operations by allowing Airport safety, security, operations and maintenance vehicles access remote areas of the airfield and the perimeter of airport property.

PFC Request Amount: \$135,000

PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50

4. Design/Construct Runway 6 RSA Improvements

Project Description: The Runway 6 RSA was identified as non-compliant in longitudinal and transverse grading as a part of a FAA Part 139 inspection in March 2015. To bring the RSA into compliance, substantial grading is required, as well as modifications to FEMA flood mapping and modifications to airport navigational aids. The project includes environmental, design, and construction activities.

Project Justification: The project will enhance airport safety in compliance with FAA's regulations.

PFC Request Amount: \$195,073
PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50

5. Terminal Upgrades – Design/Construction

Project Description: Use of the passenger terminal is being compromised by mechanical, electrical, plumbing, HVAC, communications, building finishes, and other systems and equipment that are beyond their service life. The Airport proposes to renovate the passenger terminal to replace these deficient building systems, and to alleviate functional deficiencies in the building layout. The renovated passenger terminal will provide for improved comfort and use of the facility by passengers, airlines, tenants, and staff.

Project Justification: This project is intended to maintain capacity and enhance the opportunity for competition at the airport by providing a terminal building with adequate operating systems and terminal layout that benefits all existing and future air carriers and the flying public.

PFC Request Amount: \$2,610,800
PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50

6. PFC Administration

Project Description: The airport has retained a consultant to assist it in preparing Passenger Facility Charge (PFC) Application Number 7, amend PFC #6, and prepare the closing of PFC # 4 and PFC #5 Applications.

Project Justification: Enhance capacity safety.

PFC Request Amount: \$33,755
PFC Impose Rate: \$4.50
